

Seven Sisters Tree Site Report

This site was created in 2000 by a group of six Trustees and their families. Each Trustee family has an oak tree as a living memorial.

The seventh tree is dedicated to residents of Farthinghoe, where ashes of villagers may be scattered. A fee is charged. Stewardship membership is open to all at an annual subscription of £10.

A time capsule is buried at the site, to which children of the School in 2000 contributed along with other villagers.

This year marks our 25th anniversary.

Name plaques have been placed on the fence to indicate who bought and planted the tree. This should save confusion when villagers wish to scatter ashes.
